A Guide for Users

Thirty-two years of the Monterey History and Art Association's quarterly bulletin, *Noticias del Puerto de Monterey* are indexed here. There are three parts to the index:

Illustration & Photograph Index. p.1-11
Title Index.p.12-26
Subject & Author Index. p.27-127

Some key points to be aware of when using the index include:

- Personal names are listed before place names when the names are the same. For example, "Greenfield, Edward" is listed before "Greenfield (city)."
- For variant spellings of names, standard biographical reference tools were consulted, and the most widely accepted spelling was used.
- Government and military titles are usually omitted. If first names are missing, then titles are sometimes used

to provide more information about the individuals.

- Pages noted as “i” indicate unpaged cover pages.
- Italicized entries denote authors.
- Personal and place names beginning with articles such as “el” or “la” proved to be a challenge. When the articles are consistently part of the names—“El Estero,” “La Mirada” the entries are alphabetized under “el” and “la.” If the articles are not consistently used with names, the articles are ignored. For this reason “El Cuartel” is listed with the “c” entries under “Cuartel.” To help the user, many cross-references to the indexed names are provided.
